## MISCELLANEOUS

- NO Digital markers are to be used; lead markers only - out of the area of interest
- All external metal/radiopaque objects must be removed from the area of interest

	AP / Lat Cervical

	Swimmers View	if needed
	AP / Lat Lumbar	include all of the sacrum/coccyx
	AP / Lat Upper Extremities	humerus and forearm - bilateral
	AP / Lat Lower Extremities	femur and tib-fib - bilateral
	AP Pelvis	
	AP Ribs	
	PA Chest	
Skeletal Survey (metabolic dz)	Perform all views above and add AP and Lateral bilateral Hand and Foot views	
Shunt Series	AP / Lat Skull	
	AP / Lat Chest	
	AP / Lat Abdomen	to include symphysis pubis
Bone Age	PA	Left Hand to include wrist
Bone Survey (pediatric)	AP / Lat Skull	for non-accidental trauma

### Pediatrics - Patients age 14 and younger

- Comparison views on all extremities
- Shield gonads in all cases, except when shield covers specific part to be examined radiographically
