## **RUQ and GB ULTRASOUND**

Indication	RUQ pain, abnormal lab values,
Prep	NPO as necessary
Procedure	<ul> <li>Obtain complete patient history.         <ul> <li>Current and past symptoms</li> <li>Recent laboratory and other test results</li> <li>Relevant risk factors</li> <li>Past surgeries</li> </ul> </li> <li>Enter patient data into real-time scanner</li> <li>Select abdomen set up or other appropriate machine setting selection</li> <li>Apply ultrasound gel to patient's abdominal region (RUQ)</li> <li>With patient in a supine position begin scanning</li> </ul> <li>Liver, GB, CBD, and pancreas must be imaged</li> <li>Longitudinal image of the liver including the Rt. Kidney is also required</li> <li>If the gallbladder is absent, document the GB fossa and note in technologist comments</li> <li>When scanning a single organ only, use color Doppler to confirm flow. Also, provide images documenting relationship to adjacent organs.</li>
