

Gastrografin Mixtures (Oral & Rectal)



These mixtures are to be used with Gastrografin <u>37% Organically Bound</u> Iodine concentration.

CT: 25 mL of Gastrografin mixed into 4 cups (1 liter) of water. *To enhance the taste, you may add flavoring to the water such as Crystal Light or Tang, etc. Or you may substitute Gatorade in place of the water.*



Fluoro: **Adult** oral dosage may range from 30 to 90 mL, depending on the nature of the examination and the size of the patient.

Infants and children less than 5 years- 30 mL are usually adequate. Children 5 to 10 years- the suggested dose is 60 mL.

These pediatric doses may be diluted 1:1, if desired, with water, carbonated beverage. <u>NOTE</u>: These flavorings may contain ingredients that your patient has a sensitivity to, if this is the case water without flavoring should be used.



CT: 120 mL of Gastrografin mixed into 4 cups (1 liter) of water. *This mixture should be placed in an enema bag.*

Gastrografin enema in fluoro: 240 mL Gastrografin diluted with 500 - 700 mL water mixed in a 1000 mL enema bag.



Adults: 60 mL of Gastrografin undiluted.
