Scan Range	Sufficient to cover brachial plexus from the contralateral spinous process of C-spine down to level of Sternoclavicular joint.
FOV	Fits to patient, FOV large enough to cover whole brachial plexus unilateral.
Patient Position	Supine, head first, NV coil
Localizer	3 plane scout
Breathing	Instruct patient to avoid swallowing during sequence acquistion.
